Regulations for preventing violence, racism, xenophobia, and intolerance in Sport and the Access Regulations for La Liga Stadiums

Reasons for suspension or permanent loss of access to the stadium grounds:

- 1)_ Participating in disputes, fights, or public disorder.**
- 2)_ Attempting to smuggle, carry, or use any type of weapon or object that may be used as weapons.**
- 3)_ Objects weighing more than 500g able to be used as projectiles.**
- 4)_ Attempting to smuggle or possessing flares, firecrackers, explosives, or any type of flammable product or substance.**
- 5)_ Attempting to smuggle or sell any type of alcohol beverage, narcotics, psychotropic drugs, or stimulants.**
- 6)_ Attempting to smuggle or display banners, flags, symbols, or other signs that may be used to incite violence or terrorism.**
- 7)_ Chanting, shouting, noises, or behaviours that incite violence or terrorism.**
- 8)_ Entering the field of play.**
- 9)_ Attempting to enter while still under sanction from any other sporting ground.**
- 10)_ Attempting to bring any device or means of recording, playing, broadcasting, or sharing of images, sound, data and/or statistics related to the match, excluding personal and private use.**

The stadium ground is under video surveillance for the safety of the spectators and participants of the match.
